ADVERTISEMENT

The municipality invites applications from suitably qualified persons to serve as members of the De Poort Advisory Committee. The Advisory Committee will comprise of a maximum of 12 experienced individuals with expertise in the areas of, but not limited to, tourism industry, heritage industry, urban design and spatial development, business management, economic development and sport and recreation. These individuals must meet the requirements listed below.

Requirements:

Candidates are required to have two or more of the following qualifications:

- A tertiary qualification related to the area of speciality;
- 5 years or more relevant experience in a management position in respect of the sectors stipulated above; and
- Preference will be given to local residents representative of Drakenstein communities.

An understanding of the public sector business and exposure in serving on other committees involved in culture, arts, heritage, urban design, sport and recreation, hospitality and/or business forums, would be an added advantage.

Remuneration: No remuneration will be payable to members.

Duties: The role of the Advisory Committee is to provide strategic guidance to the municipality regarding the strategic utilisation and development of the De Poort Facility;

Advice in terms of above will not extend to day to day operational activities.

Note: Applications are in respect of serving on the De Poort Advisory Committee in a voluntary and non-remunerated position. The application is not for a vacant position within the municipality. Successful candidates will be appointed by Council for a 3 year period. However re-appointment, not exceeding two terms, is possible.

Interested individuals should submit their applications accompanied by a CV of 5 pages or less and a letter of motivation. Certified copies of your highest qualifications must accompany your application. Applications must be in writing and accompanied by a letter of nomination by an expert in the afore-mentioned fields.
