UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that

1. It be noted that the municipality provided a cost estimate for the consolidation and upgrading of the seven service connections to the said bulk supply. This consolidation includes the breaking down and removal of current power lines. The quotation to landowner was R2,549,190.10 to be paid to the municipality, if the municipality performs the task.

If the landowner performs the task himself, the outcome must comply with municipal regulations and standards and be approved accordingly;

2. In terms of Section 14 of the Municipal Finance Management Act (Act No 56 of 2003) approval be granted for the alienation of a ±662 meter (11kV) municipal overhead powerline located over private property, Portion 4 of Farm No. 956, Paarl (Donkerhoek Farm) to the landowner of Farm 956, Paarl at an amount of R42,586,93 (VAT excluded);
3. All costs related to the dismantling of the remaining existing 11kV overhead lines and installation as well as the commissioning of the proposed high-tension metering panel will be for the account of the purchaser including the registration of a servitude for the installation of the proposed metering panel; and



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4. Should the owner in future decide to request the Municipality to change from the proposed private electrical reticulation system to individual municipal metering system as currently installed, the owner will be responsible for all costs involved herein.

Several questions were posed, relating inter alia to whether the closure is legal and if a public participation process was followed. Concern was also expressed, that this approval might result in an undesirable precedent resulting in the proliferation of gated communities. After the Executive Mayor responded, the matter was put to the vote and the recommendations of the Mayoral Committee were adopted by 38 votes for and 23 votes against, with no abstentions.

Closing of the Cul de Sac Kleinschmidt Street off Bo-Plein Street be approved, subject to the following conditions:

1. The residents of Kleinschmidt Street accept full responsibility for the erection of the fence to close off the street at the Bo-Plein Street entrance;
2. The residents submit the required plans for consideration and approval and payment of all fees;
3. The residents agree to all aspects related to the installation of the fence according to municipal requirements and payment of all costs thereof, as well as the maintenance of the fence;
4. Access be available on a twenty-four hour, seven days per week basis to all municipal and other emergency services, as well as municipal maintenance personnel;
5. Residents agree to all responsibility for risk associated to the closure of the street, including all damages to municipal infrastructure crossing the fence as well as those services present within the closed off area, and all physical personal injury or consequence of emergency personnel not being able to attend to the emergency timeously, as well as any financial or legal issues that may arise; and
6. The municipality reserve the right to remove the fence in the event that the maintenance thereof is not done to the satisfaction of the municipality or for any other reasonable consideration.

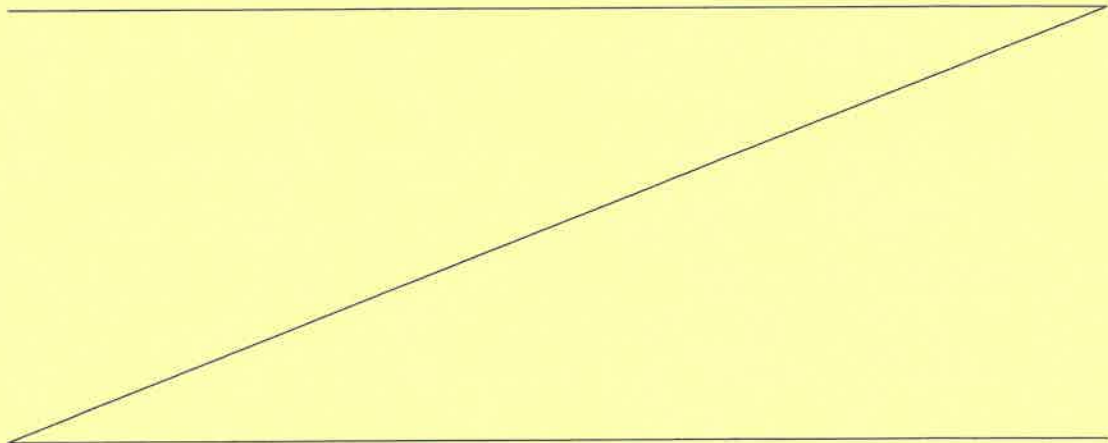

- (3) Any motion intended in terms of sub rules (1) and (2) must comply with the provisions of rule 33(2).

Recommendation by executive mayor or committee regarded as motion

37. (1) A recommendation contained in a report submitted by the executive mayor or a committee is considered to have been moved by the executive mayor or the chairperson of such committee or their delegates, as the case may be.
- (2) A motion referred to in sub rule (1) does not need to be seconded.
- (3) The executive mayor or the chairperson of the committee may exercise his or her right to speak or reply on such a matter.

Questions

38. (1) After a motion or amendment has been moved and seconded or at the conclusion of a speech thereon, a member may ask any question relevant to such motion or amendment.
- (2) No supplementary questions may be asked except by the member asking the original question and then only in respect of matters arising out of the reply to such original question.
- (3) The speaker may not disallow such question, provided that the member to whom the question is directed may either reply thereto forthwith or require that notice thereof be given in terms of rule (34).

Motion of exigency

39. (1) A member may direct the attention of the council to any matter which does not appear on the agenda and of which no previous notice has been given by stating briefly the subject of the matter and without comment thereon moving "that the motion to which attention has been directed be considered forthwith as a matter of exigency."

- (2) Such motion is herein referred to as a motion of exigency.
- (3) If such motion is seconded and carried by a majority of two thirds of the members present, the mover shall be permitted without notice to bring the matter under consideration by way of motion or question.

Motions of course

40. (1) In addition to those provided for elsewhere in these rules, the following shall be regarded as motions of course –
- (a) that any report referred to in the agenda be noted, adopted, acted upon or referred back;
 - (b) that any document before the council be acted upon in the manner specified in the motion;
 - (c) that action be taken in regard to any item submitted for consideration in the manner specified in the motion.
- (2) Any motion of course as stipulated above and elsewhere in these rules, shall be subject to rule 15 hereof.

Points of order

41. A member may raise a point of order to draw attention to a departure from these rules by stating the particular rule he or she relies on, whereupon he or she shall immediately be heard.

Points of explanation

42. The speaker may allow a member to raise a point of explanation provided that such explanation shall be confined to some material part of the debate which may have been misunderstood.

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1. Is die Burgemeester bewus van die sogenaamde Wastepreneurs-projek;

Ja, ek is bewus van die loodsprojek wat deur die Departement Vaste-afval in Wyk 17 bestuur word. Raadslid, ons moet almal bewus van hierdie projek, want dit was goed gekommunikeer. Dit is aan die media gekommunikeer, asook via WhatsApp en 'n stemboodskap aan geaffekteerde Raadslede gestuur.

Ja, Raadslid Fourie, ek is bewus daarvan en selfs u is ook terdeë ingelig.

Omdat dit 'n loodsprojek, net in Wyk 17 was, is die vorige Wyksraadslid ten volle betrokke met die identifisering van die projek en hy was in konstante verbinding met inwoners (wykskomitee).

2. Kan die Burgemeester volle besonderhede bekend maak;

Ja. Eerstens, is daar 'n belangrike onderskeid om te maak tussen dromkrappers en straatrollie-entrepreneurs. Dromkrappers is mense wat in die strate rondloop, in dromme krap en die strate bemors. Straatrollie-entrepreneurs is spesifiek gefokus om herwinning te doen vir materiale soos glas, karton, plastiek, metaal en dan ook kos.

Tweedens, dromkrappery is al vir meer as 20 jaar deel van ons samelewing. Mense wil eenvoudig 'n bestaan maak. Dit is ook om mense 'n eenvoudige lewensvatbare bestaan te gee om op 'n eerbare wyse 'n inkomste te verdien. Dit was ook die geval op die Wellington-stortingsterrein waar daar ook onwettige informele herwinnaars op die terrein herwinning gedoen het. Die Munisipaliteit het beheer geneem oor die situasie en vandag verdien die mense R 1500/week (in vergelyking met R250/week toe hulle op die stortingsterrein was). Vir hierdie projek het Drakenstein Munisipaliteit 'n nasionale prys gewen en word nasionaal erken as 'n leier gesien op die vaste-afvalgebied.

3. Is hierdie projek ten volle of gedeeltelik in werking gestel;

Soos ek voorheen beaam het, is die loodsprojek in Wyk 17. Ons is tans in Fase 1; dit sal na die verskillende Wyke uitgerol word. Dit sal deur die MMC en sy wyksraadslid gekommunikeer word.

Fase 2 behels 'n meer omvattende deelnameproses met die Wyksraadlede en hulle Wykskomitee.

4. Is daar enige beginsel besluit deur enige Portefeuljekomitee en/of Burgemeesterskomitee en/of Raadsvergadering oorweeg en goedgekeur.

Nee. Soos genoem, dis 'n loodsprojek.

5. Was daar enige openbare deelname vir insette deur die belastingbetalers en/of belangegroeppe.

Ja, dit was goed gekommunikeer. Daar was deelname in Wyk 17. Daar sal weer breër deelname wees in die volgende fase.

1. Is the Mayor aware of the so-called Wastepreneurs project;

Yes, I am aware of the pilot project being managed by the Department of Solid Waste in Ward 17. Councillor, we all need to be aware of this project because it was well communicated. This was communicated to the media and was also sent via WhatsApp and a voice message to affected Council members.

Yes, Councillor Fourie, I am aware of this and even you have been thoroughly informed.

Because it was a pilot project, only in Ward 17, the previous Ward Councillor is fully involved in identifying the project and he has been in constant contact with residents (ward committee).

2. Can the Mayor disclose full details;

Yes. First, there is an important distinction to make between waste pickers and street trolley entrepreneurs. Waste Pickers are people who roam the streets, scratching bins and littering the streets. Street trolley entrepreneurs are specifically focused on recycling materials such as glass, cardboard, plastic, metal and then also food. Second, waste picking has been a part of our society for more than 20 years. People simply want to make a living. It is also to give people a simple viable existence to earn an income in an honorable way. This was also the case at the Wellington landfill where there were also illegal informal recyclers recycling at the site. The Municipality took control of the situation and today the people earn R1500/week (compared to R250/week when they were at the landfill). For this project, Drakenstein Municipality won a national prize and is nationally recognized as a leader in the solid waste area.

3. Has this project been fully or partially implemented;

As I previously reiterated, the pilot project is in Ward 17. We are currently in Phase 1; it will be rolled out to the various Wards. This will be communicated by the MMC and its ward councillor. Phase 2 involves a more comprehensive participation process with the Ward Council members and their Ward Committee.

4. Has any principle decision been considered and approved by any Portfolio Committee and/or Mayoral Committee and/or Council meeting;

No. As mentioned, it's a pilot project

5. Was there any public participation for input by the taxpayers and/or interest groups;

Yes, it was well communicated, there was participation in Ward 17. There will be broader participation in the next phase.
