The ANC indicated that it was opposed to the property being leased to the applicant unless a provision was included that guarantee access to other community organisations. The party also suggested that it should not be up to the lessee only to decide whether other requests for access to the hall should be granted or not.

The Executive Mayor pointed out the conditions of lease already include a provision that access to use the facility by community organisations be allowed as far as possible.

After a recess requested by the ANC, the recommendation of the Mayoral Committee was put to the vote and carried by 43 votes to 12 votes and 3 abstentions.
