The GOOD party indicated that they cannot support the recommendations as in their view the evaluation is too low and should, based on their own evaluation, be R20/m². After feedback provided by both Cllr Baron and Ald Combrink, the recommendations of the Mayoral Committee were put to the vote and carried by 39 votes for to 17 votes against with 2 abstentions.

RESOLVED that

- In terms of Regulation 34 of the Municipal Asset Transfer Regulations read together with Paragraph 13 of the Asset Transfer Policy (2021) approval be granted for the lease of portions of Erven 411 and 34 Wellington situated in Stokery Road,

measuring approximately 617m² in extent to Van Zyl Family Trust and Juwico Beleggings CC for parking development purposes for light vehicles only, subject to the standard lease conditions as well as the following terms and conditions:

- 1.1 The portions of Erven 411 and 34 Wellington be leased at a market related rental amount of R654.76 per month (R1/m²) (VAT excluded, including 6% per annum escalation);
- 1.2 The lease endures for a period of three (3) years;
- 1.3 The subject properties only be used by the two adjacent landowners for parking development purposes for light vehicles and no permanent structures will be permitted;
- 1.4 The lessees accept responsibility for the maintenance of the subject properties;
- 1.5 24-Hour access to the municipal services traversing the subject properties must be provided to the Municipality when required;
- 1.6 Access to the leased portions must be taken from the existing Erven 9907 and 9235 Wellington;
- 1.7 The flow of the stormwater must not be obstructed;
- 1.8 No permanent structures to be erected on the subject properties;
- 1.9 Fencing to be erected and material to be used for the surface of the parking area must be approved by the Engineering Services Department;
- 1.10 The lessees will be responsible for all municipal services, connection fees and services consumption, etc. if applicable;
- 1.11 Municipal services must be identified on site by the Engineering Services Department before any temporary structures are to be erected and may not be erected without approved building plans;
- 1.12 Any damage caused to municipal services will be repaired at the cost of the lessees; and
- 1.13 All administrative, legal and technical requirements be adhered to.



2. In terms of paragraph 13 of the Asset Transfer Policy, the lease of the property be granted by way of direct negotiations as the subject properties can only be used by the adjacent landowners of Erven 9907 and 9235 Wellington and not as an individual property by another party.
