

EPWP MECHANICAL YOUTH JOBSEEKERS

Drakenstein Municipality invites qualifying youth to apply for technical EPWP training opportunities within the mechanical workshop and other departments at the municipality.

A. EPWP STUDENTS – TECHNICAL TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Students (youth) with technical training in (i) welding, (ii) auto-electrical, (iii) mechanic, (iv) plumber and (v) electrician.

Students will be registered for varied amounts of modular training based on prior learning. All students will be required to gain practical experience and pass the applicable trade test.

B. EPWP YOUTH OPERATOR TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Youth with skills and training in operating (i) construction equipment (digger loader and front-end loader) or (ii) tipper trucks.

GENERAL SELECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR THESE OPPORTUNITIES ARE

South African citizen
Aged below 30 years of age
Residence in the Drakenstein municipal area
Fluent in two of the three official languages of the Western Cape
Unemployed
Access to own transport or willing to use public transport to reach training venue

ADDITIONAL SELECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TECHNICAL EXPERIENTIAL TRAINING ARE

Grade 11 with maths and science
Conduct skills assessment and interview at mechanical workshop to test mechanical awareness

SELECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE OPERATOR TRAINING ARE

For the tipper truck training / experience the applicant must have a valid code EC / 10 driver's licence

ALL APPLICANTS WILL NEED TO PASS A PRACTICAL TEST OF THEIR SKILLS IN ORDER TO QUALIFY

Learners will be rotated between Drakenstein Municipality, their place of learning and private sector workshops as part of this development programme.

EPWP STIPEND:

Learners will be paid the Sector Education Training Authority (SETA) stipend per day. Currently this stipend is typically R136 per day.

Note: Proof of citizenship, residence, driver's license and results are required for assessment. (Clear copies of ID document, proof of address and certified results must be attached)
