

- The Municipal Demarcation Board be informed that the proposal from Stellenbosch Municipality for the redetermination of the municipal boundary to include the Klapmuts North Area in the administrative jurisdiction of Stellenbosch Municipality, as reflected in the notice from Stellenbosch Municipality and the locality plan, attached as Annexures A and B respectively to the departmental report, not be supported;
- 2. The summarised reasons below, as elaborated on in paragraph 4.3 of this report, be communicated as the reasons for not supporting the municipal boundary redetermination proposal of Stellenbosch Municipality:
 - 2.1 The proposal from Stellenbosch Municipality is non-compliant with section 22(a)(iii) of the Local Government Municipal Demarcation Board Act, 1998, as Drakenstein Municipality does not concur with Stellenbosch Municipality on the proposal to include Klapmuts North Area into the administrative jurisdiction of Stellenbosch Municipality;
 - 2.2 No reasons, as required in terms of the Municipal Demarcation Act, 1998, were provided for the proposal to include the Klapmuts North Area into the administrative jurisdiction of Stellenbosch Municipality;
 - 2.3 The Klapmuts North Area was incorporated into the administrative jurisdiction of Drakenstein Municipality during the amalgamation of municipalities process in 2000, whilst the erven situated south of the N1 was incorporated into the administrative jurisdiction of Stellenbosch Municipality;
 - 2.4 Drakenstein Municipality has considerable vested interest in the development of the Klapmuts North Area as a valuable municipal asset was recently alienated by the municipality in order to facilitate the development of the Klapmuts North Area;

- 2.5 The redetermination of municipal boundaries to include the Klapmuts North Area into the municipal jurisdiction of Stellenbosch will render the efforts and momentum gained by Drakenstein Municipality in the development of the Klapmuts North Area as fruitless, as new institutional arrangements and relationships with land owners within the Klapmuts North Area will have to be forged by Stellenbosch Municipality;
- 2.6 The delays and administrative consequence as a result the redetermination of the municipal boundary will have a dire impact on the much-needed accelerated economic growth within the two municipalities, the region and the province;
- 2.7 The redetermination of municipal boundaries to include the Klapmuts North Area into the municipal jurisdiction of Stellenbosch will have a major impact on the amount of voters within the applicable municipal ward and will result in a significant municipal ward delimitation process within Drakenstein Municipality prior to the next local government elections:
- 2.8 Drakenstein Municipality has utilized a considerable amount of resource on the Klapmuts North Area and the future of the Klapmuts North Area is well rooted within the basis of strategic planning for Drakenstein Municipality; and
- 2.9 The redetermination of municipal boundaries to include the Klapmuts North Area into the municipal jurisdiction of Stellenbosch will require that the 2022–2027 IDP, SDF and Long Term Revenue and Expenditure Framework of Drakenstein Municipality, as well as Stellenbosch Municipality, be amended. The amendment of the aforementioned critical strategic documents of the municipality will require the reprioritization of municipal priorities and resources, which will inevitably delay the implementation of already planned strategic interventions and projects.


