The GOOD party expressed their concerns regarding public access to the river which might be compromised if the application is to be approved. Councilor K Gertse (GOOD party) undertook to provide his questions in writing to the administration for circulation



to the MMC to respond.

The four members of the GOOD party indicated that they are not in support of the item and voted against the recommendations, whereas the remaining councillors present at the meeting voted in favour of the recommendations.

#### **RESOLVED** that

- 1. In terms of Section 14 of the MFMA Council resolves that:
  - 1.1 The subject property is not needed to provide the minimum level of basic municipal services; and
  - 1.2 The fair market value of the asset and the economic and community value to be received in exchange for the asset has been considered.
- 2. In terms of Section 14 of the Municipal Finance Management Act (No.56 of 2003) approval be granted for the alienation of a portion of Remainder Erf 5058 Paarl, measuring approximately 3115m² in extent, to the adjacent landowner of Erf 19147 Paarl, Landhold Properties (Pty) Ltd, Registration no. 1999/007845/07 for parking development purposes only, at a market related selling price of R124,600.00 (R40/m²) (VAT excluded), subject to the standard conditions of sale as well as the following conditions:
  - 2.1 All land use rights including closure, subdivision and rezoning be undertaken by and at the cost of the purchaser. All costs related to the transaction will be for the purchaser's account;
  - 2.2 The portion of Remainder Erf 5058 Paarl must not be consolidated and the newly subdivided erf be registered as a single erf in the name of the purchaser;
  - 2.3 The southern portion is subject to severe flooding during winter months and the Municipality be indemnified against any claims for damages caused by the flooding;
  - 2.4 A Water Use Authorisation must be obtained from the Department of Water Affairs and Sanitation, which will form part of the land use planning application process to be undertaken by and at the cost of the applicant;
  - 2.5 The property may only be used for open and carport parking purposes, which restriction must be registered against the title of the subject property together with a building restriction servitude;
  - 2.6 No construction will be permitted on the subject property, with the exception of a boundary fencing;
  - 2.7 Access to and from the entire portion of Erf 5058 Paarl to be used for parking purposes be taken from Distillery Street;

- 2.8 All landscaping must be undertaken in consultation with the Parks and Environmental Management Divisions;
- 2.9 Stormwater to be discharged directly into the river with the necessary approvals from the municipal Engineering Services Department;
- 2.10 Maintenance of the area behind the proposed fencing to be erected for the parking area near the riverbank must be undertaken by and at the cost of the purchaser;
- 2.11 The riparian area of the Berg River (included in the applicant's property) be kept clear of invasive alien vegetation at the cost of the applicant;
- 2.12 Access to the riverbank must be provided to the Municipality as and when required; and
- 2.13 All other technical and environmental conditions imposed by the technical departments be adhered to.
- 3. In terms of Paragraph 13 of the Asset Transfer Policy the direct alienation of non-viable properties of municipal land is permitted. In this instance, this portion of Remainder Erf 5058 Paarl is a non-viable portion of land which can only be utilised by the adjacent landowner for parking purposes only. The subject property on its own cannot be utilised by other individuals, however once incorporated with the existing properties, Erven 39593 and 19147 Paarl, it can be utilised more effectively.



# CLLR. K GERTSE MOTION OF EXIGENCY IN TERMS OF RULE 39(1).

Cllr. K Gertse: The GOOD Party wishes to bring before council an incident that took place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April 2024 at 03 Blake Street, Paarl Central, Paarl where two unmarked security officers trespassed on the abovementioned premises, proceeded to intimidate the family, pointed a firearm at an adult male and took unconsented photographic images of two adult males. GOOD wishes to further place on record that the family in question are the legal occupants of a residents, owned by council, against whom Drakenstein successfully obtained an eviction order that is currently inactive, pending a 6-month grace period under a new negotiated deal with the municipality.

The family, with the support of the GOOD party brought a criminal case (case 293/04/2024) against the security officers on the grounds of trespassing, intimidation, illegally pointing of a firearm and crimen injuria.

These unlawful acts allegedly took place under instruction from Drakenstein and GOOD is currently in possession of an affidavit supporting these claims, in addition to it presenting the name of a municipal employee possibly tied to this event.

GOOD proposes that council sanctions an investigation to investigate the allegations of Drakensteins involvement. Furthermore, any employee involved in authorizing this crime, be suspended pending the outcome of the municipal investigation. GOOD further calls that the Terms of Reference under which this security company is in the employ of Drakenstein, as well as any form of communication between the municipality and this company, whether inbound or outbound, across all digital platforms, be made available to council.
