- 1.7 The following tariff increases/decreases for the revenue streams of property rates, fees, charges and tariffs with effect from 1 July 2021:
- 1.7.1 Property rates tariff decrease of 2%;
 - 1.7.2 Water tariff increase of 6.0%;
 - 1.7.3 Sewerage/sanitation tariff increase of 6.0%;
 - 1.7.4 Refuse removal tariff increase of 7.5%;
 - 1.7.5 Electricity tariff increase of 14.59%.
- 1.8 The annual budget of Drakenstein Municipality for the 2021/2022 financial year as well as the indicative estimates for the four outer financial years (2022/2023 to 2025/2026) as set out in the new mSCOA version 6.5 Schedules A1 to A10 and SA1 to SA38 included in Appendix 1 of the 2021/2026 MTREF Budget Report.



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- 1.9 The ten year Capital Expenditure Framework (CEF) for the Integrated Urban Development Grant attached as Annexure C to the item.
- 1.10 Ward allocations to the total amount of R6,600,000 which equals to R200,000 per ward. An amount of R30,000 per ward is allocated to ward committee stipends and the remainder of the R170,000 per ward is allocated to specific approved themes as disclosed in Annexure E which are budgeted according to mSCOA expenditure line items. The nine wards which have not finalized the R170,000 appropriation with the approval of the MTREF 2021/2022 budget will not be able to spend the R170,000 until it is prioritised according the specific themes that must be approved in a subsequent adjustments budget during the 2021/2022 financial year.
2. It is recommended that Council notes, that:
- 2.1 A budgeted operating surplus of R44,612,083 is anticipated to be realised for the 2021/2022 financial year as set out in Table 3 of the 2021/2026 MTREF Budget Report.
- 2.2 Any actual cash surpluses at year-end will be used to increase Drakenstein's Capital Replacement Reserve to be utilised for future infrastructure assets investment and the redemption of external loans.
- 2.3 The envisaged increases/decreases in the property rates, fees, charges and tariffs as set in the Tariff Book attached as Annexure B to the item.
- 2.4 Drakenstein's investments and cash as at 30 April 2021 amounted to R279,346,516 made up of investments with:
- 2.4.1 FNB Primary account (R106,645,029);
 - 2.4.2 ABSA investments (R76,752,815);
 - 2.4.3 Investec investments (R55);
 - 2.4.4 Nedbank (60,233,699);
 - 2.4.5 Grindrod investments (R35,627,283); and
 - 2.4.6 Eskom (R87,635).
- 2.5 The proposed total cost to municipality expenses for the salary, allowances and benefits of the Executive Mayor, Speaker, Deputy Executive Mayor, Chief Whip, Mayoral Committee members, ordinary councillors, City Manager (CM), Chief Financial Officer (CFO) and executive directors as set out in SA23 included in Annexure D.



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- 2.6 Drakenstein Municipality do not have any current service delivery agreements, including material amendments to existing service delivery agreements, with any service provider who renders any power or function on behalf of Drakenstein Municipality as defined in Section 1 of the Municipal Systems Act.
- 2.7 Drakenstein Municipality do not have any municipal entities.
