

Drakenstein Municipality went through an extremely difficult period from April to August 2024.

This period was marked by:

- A windstorm that wreaked havoc through the municipality which resulted in extensive damage to municipal and private property. One (1) person died during the windstorm and three others were seriously injured.
- This was followed by a rainstorm a month later which caused three dams to overflow with the possibility to break their walls. This resulted in 920 households to be evacuated from Newton and Drommedaris as a precautionary measure.
- Drakenstein had to be prepared for the National and Provincial elections, which went extremely
- A new mayoral committee had to be elected.
- It took quite some time to operationalize the Budget, Integrated Development Program (IDP) and Strategic Development Budget Implementation plan (SDBIP) for easy implementation and to make it workable documents

APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY MANAGER, DR. LEIBBRANDT

The Municipal Council in November 2021 unanimously resolved to appoint Dr. Johan Leibbrandt as the City Manager for a second term. The appointment was subject to the approval by the then COGTA Minister. On 28 February 2022, former Minister Dlamini-Zuma approved the appointment only until 31 August 2022.

The Municipal Council resolved to challenge this decision and applied to review and set aside the Minister's decision.

On 22 August 2022, the Cape High Court granted an interim interdict that allowed Dr. Leibbrandt to remain in office until the final court order is made.

The High Court was to hear the case in August 2024, but before the hearing, COGTA approached our legal team and agreed to settle rather than argue the case. The agreed court order was made final and makes provision for Dr. Leibbrandt to continue to serve as City Manager, until the outcome of the next Local Government Elections.

I welcome the agreed court order, and I am thankful for the leadership of Minister Hlabisa the newly appointed Minister of COGTA. Drakenstein Municipality, under the leadership of the City Manager, has consistently delivered and proved itself as the leading secondary city in the country. This final court order will ensure excellence in financial management, good governance and service delivery until the next Local Government Elections.

I wish the City Manager well for the remainder of his term.
