

### **Update on Farm Visit and Electricity Negotiations**

Following the report tabled before Council last month, I conducted an on-site visit to the farm owner as scheduled. During the engagement, we discussed possible avenues for collaboration to assist farmworker households with the ongoing negotiations with Eskom regarding electricity connections.

The farm owner was requested to support and facilitate these discussions in order to expedite a workable solution for the affected residents.

Concerns regarding the owner's conduct, observed during the process, have been formally reported to Mr Franco Williams as well as to the Minister of Agriculture for further investigation and guidance.
