Terms and Conditions

Drakenstein Dance Challenge: Official Rules

Eligibility

- Open to school-going youth aged 7 to 19 years old.
- Participants may enter as individuals or groups.
- All dance styles are welcome (hip-hop, contemporary, traditional, street, etc.).
- Participants must be residents of or attend school in Drakenstein Municipality.

Entry requirements

Video Specifications:

- Minimum duration: 90 seconds.
- Must use the official [Drakenstein anthem](#) (full track or excerpt).
- Video must be original content created specifically for this competition.
- Clear visibility of choreography required.

How to submit

- Post your video on Facebook or Instagram as a public post.
- Tag @DrakensteinMunicipality in the post.
- Include the hashtag #DrakensteinDanceChallenge in the caption.
- Include your age or age range in the caption (e.g., "Age 12" or "Ages 14–16").

A city of excellence

- For participants under 18: Parent/guardian consent is required (comment "I give permission" on the post).

Timeline

- Competition opens: 2 March 2026
- Submissions close: 10 April 2026

Judging criteria

Winner determined by public vote based on:

- Total engagement (likes + shares + positive comments)
- Creativity and originality of choreography
- Energy and execution
- Use of the anthem

Prizes and recognition

- The winning dance stands a chance to become the official choreographed dance of the Drakenstein anthem.
- Winners featured on all Drakenstein Municipality social media platforms.
- Winners receive an official certificate of recognition.

Important rules

- Choreography must be original (not copied from existing dances).
- Content must be appropriate for all ages.
- Entries will be disqualified if they contain inappropriate language or gestures, dangerous stunts, copyright violations, or content that does not align with municipal values.
- Drakenstein Municipality reserves the right to disqualify entries that violate rules.
- By entering, participants grant permission for their video to be shared on municipal platforms. Videos may be edited or shortened for promotional purposes.
