The Training program entails: Undergoing theoretical and practical training at a public or private TVET college; working on a building site; applying health and safety regulations; maintaining work areas; and undertaking administrative tasks.

Minimum requirements:

- Between 18 and 30 years old
- Resident of the Cape Winelands District
- Plumbing Hand: Grade 10 / NQF L3 or NCV L3
- Solar Mounter: NQF L4/ Grade 12 or NCV L4 / N2 with a pass in Mathematics

Other requirements:

- Applicants must enjoy good health and be willing to undergo a medical and substance abuse examination.
- Successful applicants will be required to work on a construction site as part of the training program.
- Successful applicants must be willing to travel and work at various building sites across the Western Cape.
- Successful applicants will be required to sign a 12-month Training Agreement.

Stipend: R2 500 per month for the duration of the Training Agreement.
