- Unspent conditional and unconditional grants amounted to R44,355,941 at the end of July 2018;
- 8. The actual employee related cost expenditure of R362,951 compared with the pro rata budgeted expenditure of R49,982,562 relates to a positive variance of R49,619,611 or 99.27%;
- Total outstanding debtors as at 31 July 2018 amounted to R391,824,619 and that 30 days and older debt constitutes 52.6% of total outstanding debtors;

10. Domestic consumers owe the municipality R239,364,160 or 61.1% of the municipality's total debtor's book;
