  - 2.3 It is confirmed that the subject property is not subject to any formally registered land claims;
  - 2.4 All administrative and legal requirements be adhered to; and
  - 2.5 The conditions imposed by the technical department be adhered to.

In this instance, Erf 3636 Paarl, is a non-viable portion of land which can only be utilised by the adjacent landowners for gardening and recreational purposes as it is land-locked.

- 2.4 The transaction be subject to all requirements as indicated by the technical departments, which includes services servitudes to be registered in favour of the municipality in respect of engineering underground infrastructure traversing the subject property, if applicable; and
- 2.5 The applicant shall be responsible for the construction of the access road as indicated on diagram no 1404/2022 up to the point where the school will gain access to its premises.
3. The proposed transaction be advertised whereby interested parties will be invited to submit objections, comments and or counter-offers;
4. The transaction be subject to the standard conditions of sale, including reversionary and pre-emptive rights, noting that the municipal property may only be utilised for a school; and



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5. In terms of Paragraph 13 of the Asset Transfer Policy the direct alienation of this viable portion of municipal land is permitted as the proposed development of the much needed educational facility with affordable fees.
